Sub: Regarding allowing processing of new online NOC applications for Malls/Commercial complexes under Regulation 6.6.2 of Supply Code-2014 (Single Point Supply to a Franchisee)

1. Please refer this office earlier instructions issued vide memo no. 2213-38 dated 21.09.2021 vide which it was decided to discontinue to accept new online NOC applications under Regulation 6.6.2 of Supply Code-2014 till further orders. These instructions were amended vide memo no. 2381-2402 dated 28.10.2021 vide which it was decided to continue to accept new online NOC applications for revised NOC only from existing franchisees under Supply Code Regulation 6.6.2 due to revision of layout plan, extension in project area, contiguity etc. subject to condition that they shall only sign draft Model Franchisee Agreement 2021 till finalization of new Franchisee Agreement.
2. Thereafter, many developers represented to PSPCL for allowing NOCs under Regulation 6.6.2 of Supply Code-2014. They have shown their inability to take NOC under Regulation 6.7 of Supply Code citing space constraints for installation of outdoor oil type Distribution Transformers (DTs) of standard ratings approved by PSPCL.
3. In light of the above, the matter has been considered and it has been decided to allow processing of new NOC cases applied under Regulation 6.6.2 of Supply Code-2014 only for those Malls/Commercial Complexes which have space constraint for installation of outdoor Oil type DTs of standard ratings approved by PSPCL. This is further subject to following conditions:-
 - a. Upon receiving request from the developer for grant of NOC for Malls/Commercial Complexes under Regulation 6.6.2, the project site shall be visited by a committee comprising of concerned CE/DS and SE/DS to ascertain the genuineness of space constraint for installation of oil type DTs of standard ratings approved by PSPCL. After report of committee regarding genuineness of space constraint, NOC application shall be processed further.
 - b. The developer seeking NOC for Malls/Commercial Complexes under Regulation 6.6.2 of Supply Code-2014 shall only sign New Franchisee

Agreement, which is under approval. However during the transit period, developer will sign Draft Model Franchisee Agreement-2021 issued vide memo no. 2381-2402 dated 28.10.2021 with validity only till finalization of New Franchisee Agreement subject to condition that they shall also furnish an undertaking for signing and abiding by conditions of New Franchisee Agreement after its finalization by PSPCL.

4. As decided above, new applications for NOCs under Supply Code Regulation 6.6.2 shall only be accepted for Malls/Commercial Complexes having space constraint and shall remain discontinued for all remaining categories of projects as per earlier instructions issued vide memo no. 2213-38 dated 21.09.2021. However, applications for revised NOCs from existing Franchisees under Supply Code Regulation-6.6.2 shall continue to be accepted as per earlier instructions issue vide memo no. 2381 dated 28.10.2021.

Meticulous compliance of above instructions must be ensured.
